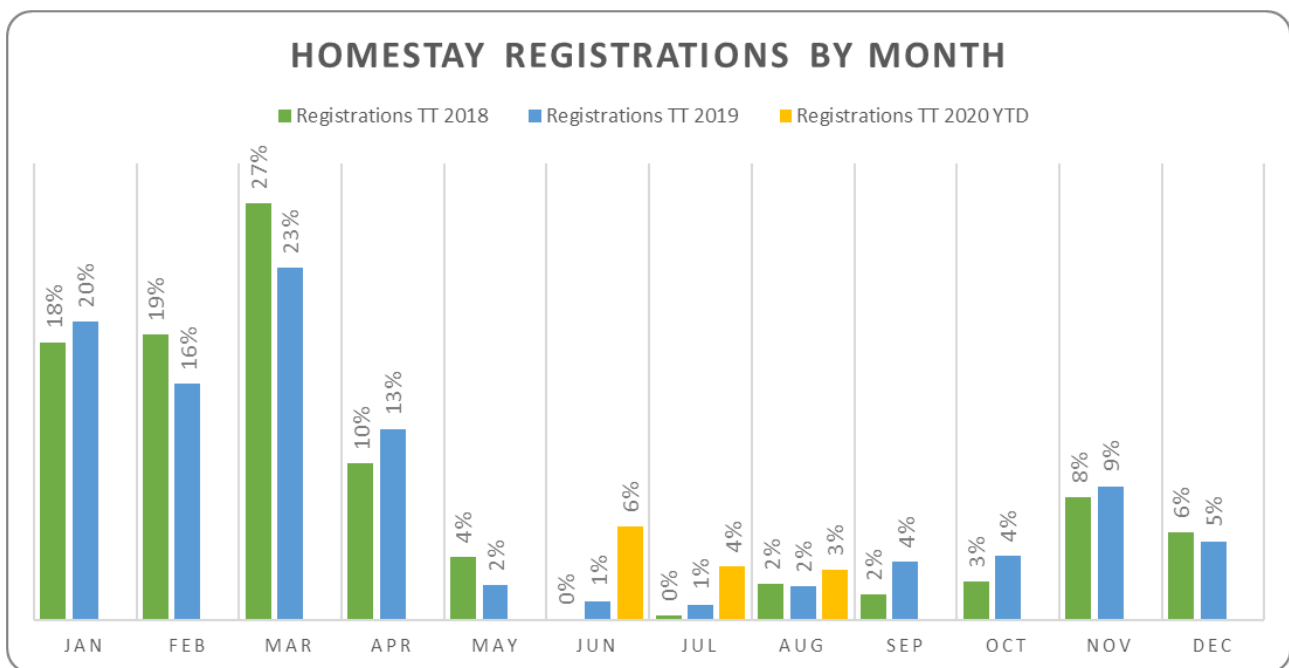


Race fans looking for accommodation for TT often contact us asking when more Homestay properties will be available. At this stage our general response to visitors is to please try and be patient, as it is still a very early for Homestay and TT 2020 (see chart below).

We ‘get it’ that this is not what visitor really want to hear, and appreciate people wanting to get their accommodation booked and plans finalised. We are actively trying to help, by opening registration straight after TT, rather than waiting until after the Festival of Motorcycling, and encouraging hosts to register earlier if they can.

As you can see below, we are having some success with June, July and August (to date) showing increases compared to previous years.

These renewals and new registrations are being processed as soon as they come in, so please keep an eye on the website <http://www.iomhomestay.com> (remember to use the “Sort By” and “Recently Updated” options), plus we will post updates and availability to our Facebook page ([IOMTTMOMESTAY](#)) and also our Facebook Group ([IoMHomestay](#)), which we encourage you to join, as it’s a place to share your accommodation requests with registered Homestay hosts.



Looking at our registration statistics for TT 2018 and TT 2019, it clearly shows a trend for most Homestay hosts to register after Christmas. Last year, we still had accommodation options available right up to the start of practice week.

We are making inroads into earlier registrations, but fully expect Homestay for TT 2020 will follow a similar pattern, as we also understand many hosts will not be able to commit to Homestay until they know their own plans for May/June 2020.
