

Homestay



We've had a couple of calls and emails from people seeking clarification on how long a Homestay registration lasts. We're guessing this is a result of a change introduced in 2017.

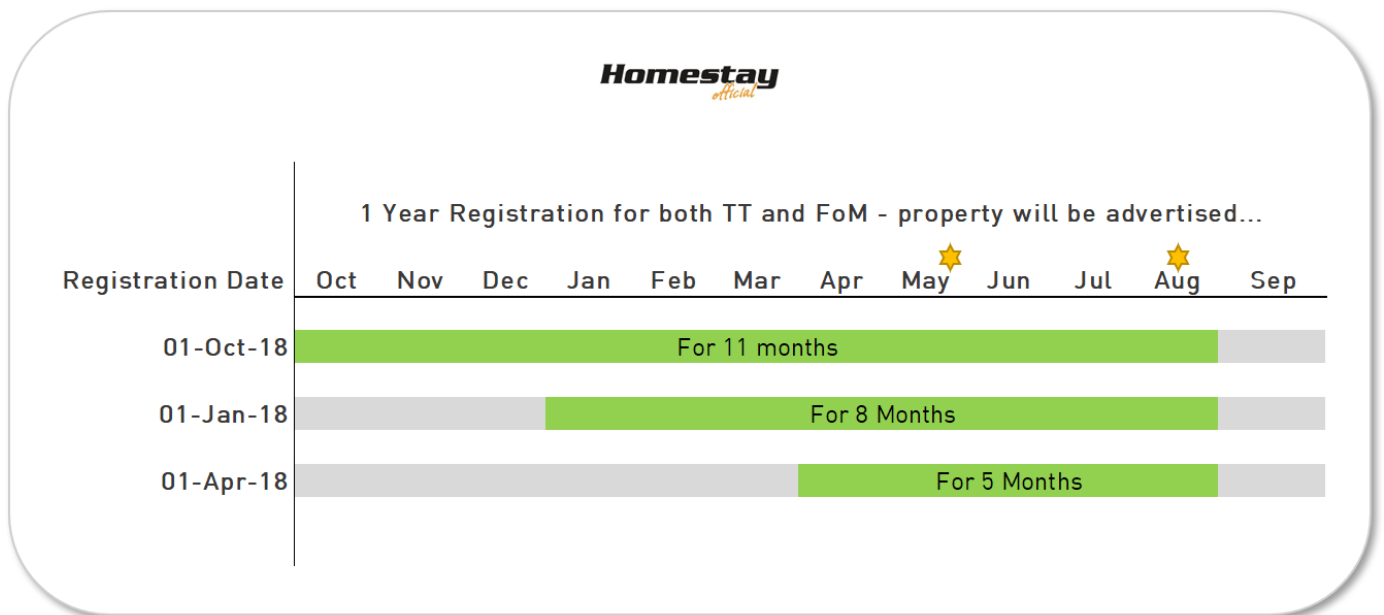
Let's take a look at how it works now. Homestay Registration options are for '1 year' or '2 years', so by default, the 'expiry date' is set for 12 or 24 months from the date of registration. Seems logical right?

However, we need to understand that Homestay applies to the TT and Festival of Motorcycling events only.

For example, it doesn't matter if you register for '1 year' in October 2018 or May 2019, in both cases you are registered and advertised for the next TT event (2019) and the next Festival of Motorcycling (2019).

Once an event has finished, you will no longer be advertised for the following years event, unless of course you chose a '2 year' registration.

Basically, the earlier you register, the longer your property is advertised for e.g.
